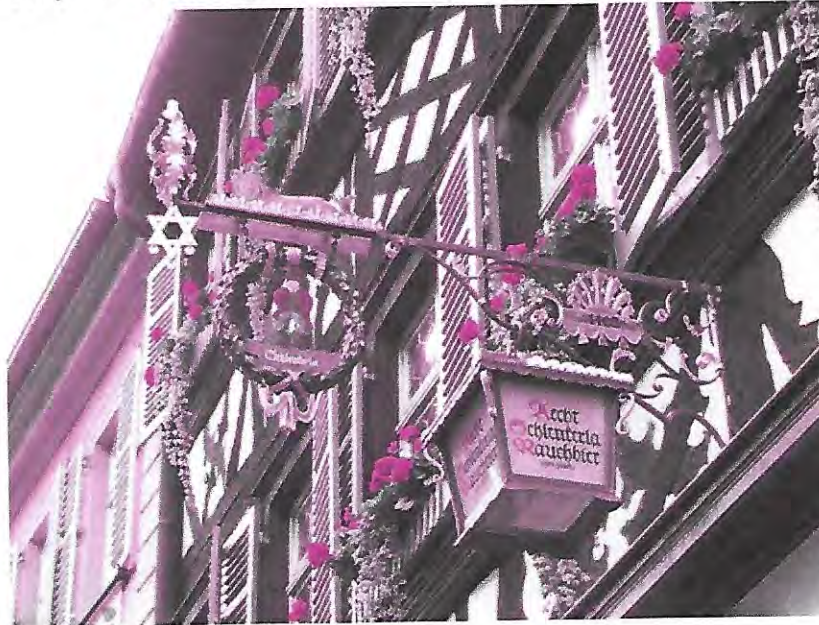


BEER: A Tour through Germany's Best-Loved Brews
