6. Berlin, Berlin

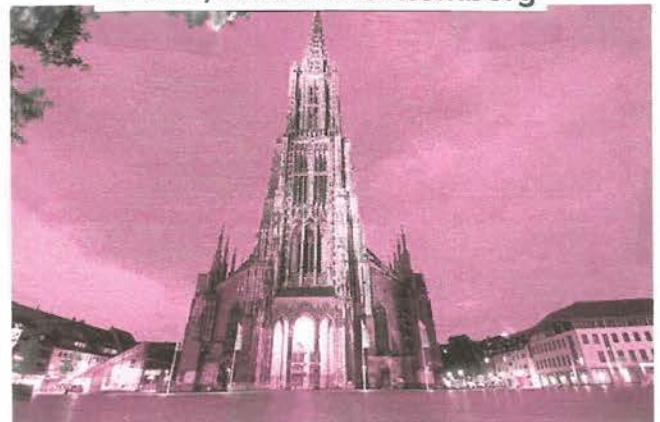
Under the shadow of Ulm’s magnificent gothic cathedral with the world’s highest church tower, the city’s Christmas market is a great stop on the Christmas market tour.

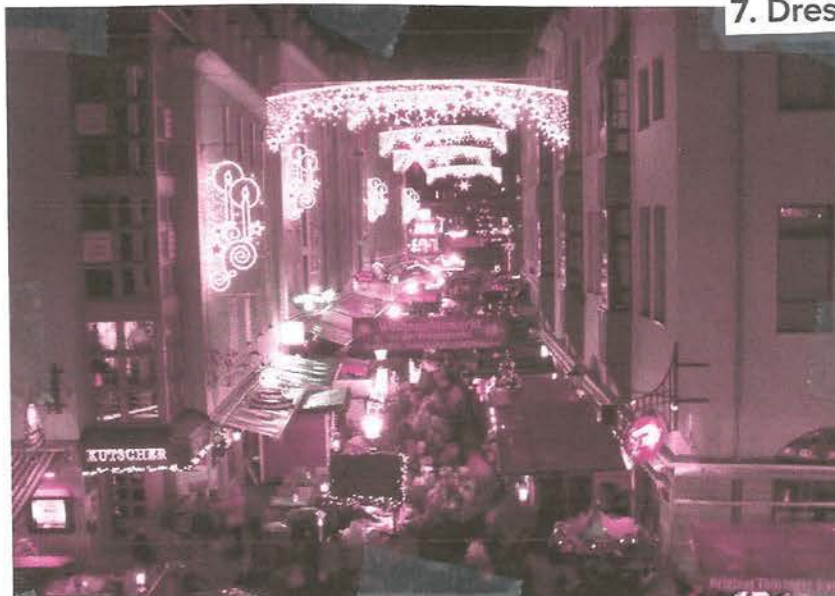
