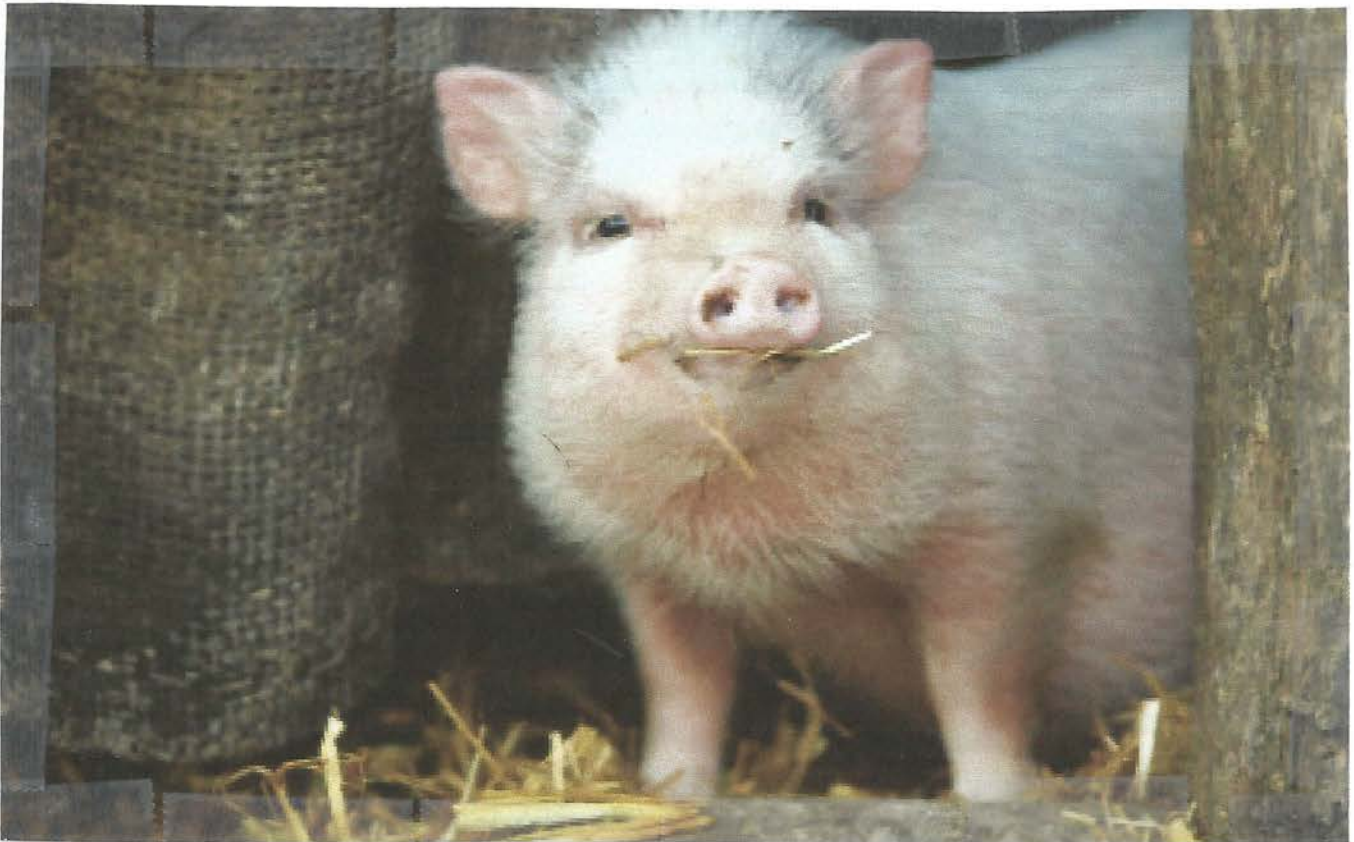

1. Saukalt
