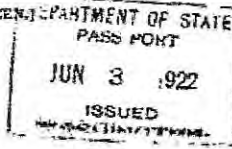
The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A loose signed photograph of the applicant must accompany the application. The photographs must be on thin paper, should have a light background, and be not over three inches in size.

This blank must be completely filled out. The legal description, date, in currency or gold coins or other, and the applicant's certificate of naturalization must accompany the application. The rules should be carefully read before making the application in the Department of State, Division of Passport Control, Washington, D. C.

I, Konrad Heinlein, a NATURALIZED AND LOYAL CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, hereby apply to the Department of State, at Washington, for a passport, accompanied by wife, Lena, born in Pittsburgh, Penna.

I solemnly swear that I was born at Germany on May 31, 1863; that my father, John Heinlein, was born in Germany and is now residing at deceased; that I emigrated to the United States, sailing from Rotterdam about 1883; that I resided 36 years, uninterruptedly, in the United States from 1883 to 1922 at Pennsylvania; that I was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the Quarter Sessions Court of Allegheny County at Pittsburgh, Penna. on March 1, 1892 as shown by the Certificate of Naturalization presented herewith; that I am the IDENTICAL PERSON described in said Certificate; that I have resided outside the United States since my naturalization at the following places for the following periods:

and that I am domiciled in the United States, my permanent residence being at Moon Twp. in the State of Penna., where I follow the occupation of Gardener. My last passport was obtained from on and was I am about to go abroad temporarily, and intend to return to the United States within 3 months with the purpose of residing and performing the duties of citizenship therein; and I desire a passport for use in visiting the countries hereinafter named for the following purpose:
