

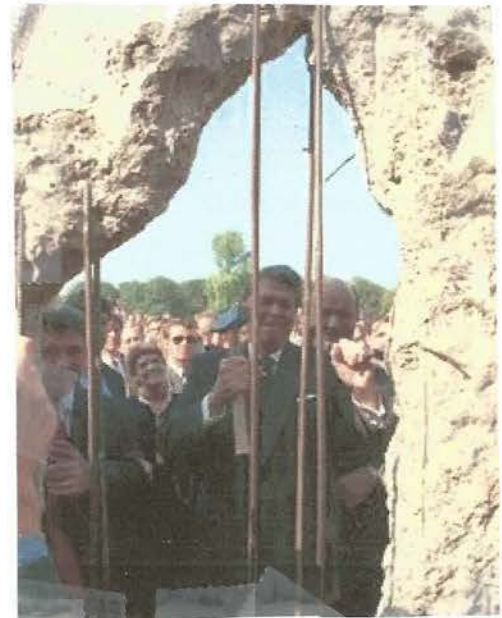

President Reagan's Speech to Mikhail Gorbachev in Berlin (der 12. Juni 1987) "Tear down this wall!" (Berlin Wall)

The Berlin-Hohenschönhausen Memorial, the main detainment facility of the East German secret police (Stasi), and the Allied Museum will jointly host a ceremony this Sunday to honor Reagan and his contribution to overcoming Communism. At the ceremony, German Defense Minister Karl-Theodor zu Guttenberg will give a speech in appreciation of the former president.
