HAMBURGER DOM

**Winterdom oder Domfest / Winter Funfair or Cathedral Market
(held from beginning of November to beginning of December)**

der 3. November bis den 3. Dezember 2017: Hamburger Winterdom or Dommarkt / Winter Fair or Cathedral Market, is the biggest and longest public festival in Northern Germany. With 3 fairs (spring, summer, and winter) per year, it attracts about 10 million visitors per year, who can experience fun, nostalgia, and thrills.

The iconic Hamburg DOM is the biggest public festival in Northern Germany, with roots going back to the 11th century. In wintertime, the old Mariendom cathedral was used as a shelter by merchants and entertainers and the tradition lasted until the cathedral was demolished in 1804.

In 1893 they finally found a new location: the Heiligengeistfeld event area in the St. Pauli district. Nowadays, the name of Hamburg's most famous fun fair is the only reminder of the old days in the cathedral.

Every year, several million people visit the Winterdom in Hamburg to socialize with Bratwurst and Glühwein and to get in the mood for Christmas and the Christmas markets. There are food stalls, fairground rides, and every Friday evening there is a large fireworks display.
