

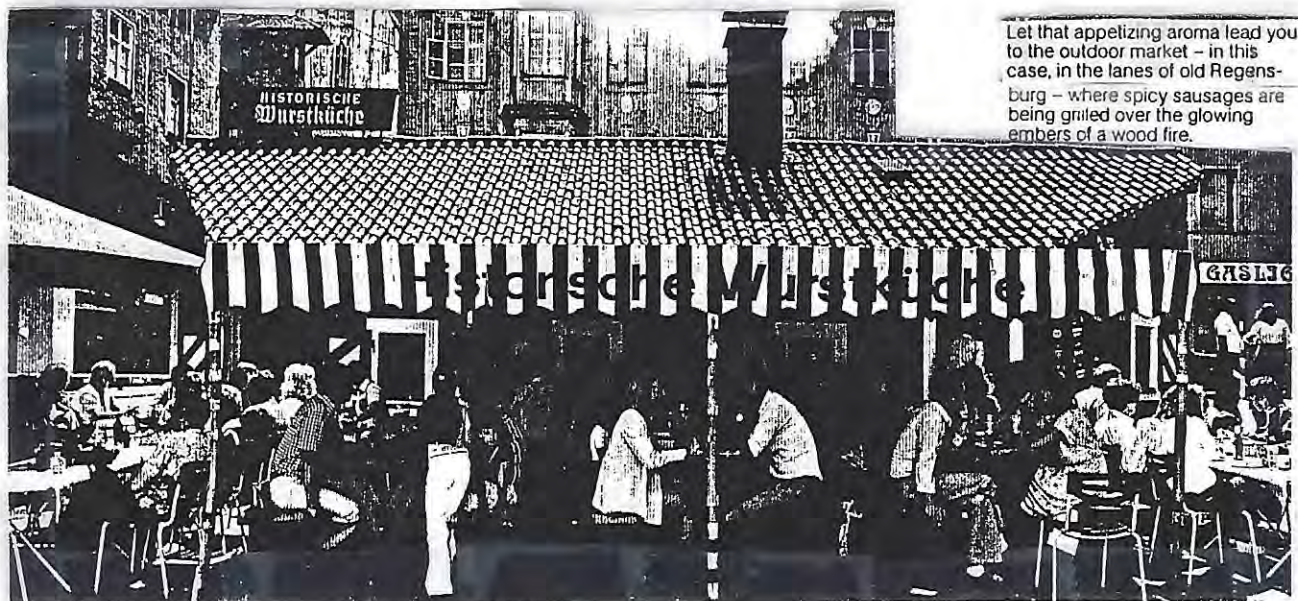
**WO KANN MAN ESSEN UND TRINKEN?**

- snack bar: der Schnellimbiß, die Schnellimbisse
- snack stand: die Schnellgaststätte, die Schnellgaststätten
- stand-up snack bar: die Imbißstube, die Imbißstuben
- snack shop: die Imbißbude, die Imbißbuden



Stalls advertising Bratwurst, Pommes-frites (chips; Chips in German means potato crisps) and perhaps Schaschlik or Gulaschsuppe, are found in every German town. These stalls reflect local tastes very markedly: in Munich they

could be selling Weißwurst or Würstl (southern German dialect for Würstchen or kleine Wurst) mit Senf, or Leberkäse, which is not a cheese but a kind of meat loaf. In other places Erbsensuppe or Brezeln may be found.



Let that appetizing aroma lead you to the outdoor market – in this case, in the lanes of old Regensburg – where spicy sausages are being grilled over the glowing embers of a wood fire.
