**Just a snack**

For a hot snack look for places advertising **warme Küche** (hot food), though many serve full meals as well.

Warme Küche von 12-18 Uhr

A *Schnellimbiss*, *Schnellgaststätte*, *Imbissstube* or simply an *Imbiss* is a snack bar where you can get sausages with bread or a roll and mustard (*Würstchen mit Brot oder Semmel mit Senf*) and a soft drink at a reasonable price. You usually eat standing at a counter or at a small round table.

Most of these snack bars offer a variety of sausages. The *Bratwurst* is fat, white and spicy; the *Currywurst* is similar, but served with a curry sauce; *Bockwurst* is longer and reddish, something like a thick American hot dog. The *Frankfurter* is thinner and usually sold in pairs. At an *Imbiss* sausages are eaten using the fingers. You don't get a bun, but often a slice of bread (*eine Scheibe Brot*) or a small roll (*Brötchen* or *Semmel*) comes with the sausages.

Other fast-food places sell pizza and American-style hamburgers and hot dogs as well as grilled chicken (*Brathähnchen*).
