Agathe Johanna Erwina Gobertina von Trapp (1913 to 2010)

Agathe Johanna Erwina Gobertina von Trapp (12 March 1913 – 28 December 2010) was the eldest daughter of Georg von Trapp and his first wife, Agathe Whitehead von Trapp. She was also a member of the Trapp Family Singers, whose lives were the inspiration for the 1959 musical play and 1965 film *The Sound of Music*. She was portrayed as the character "Liesl".^[1]

Agathe: Lives near Baltimore, Maryland, where she helps run a kindergarten.

Biography

Agathe, her six siblings, father, and stepmother, Maria Augusta von Trapp, comprised the Trapp Family Singers, who inspired the 1959 Broadway musical and the 1965 Academy Award-winning Best Picture *The Sound of Music*. The von Trapps fled Austria after the German annexation of Austria, fearing reprisals resulting from declining to sing at Hitler's birthday party and Georg von Trapp's refusal to accept a commission in the German Navy^[2]. They came to the United States in 1938, settled in Vermont in 1942^[3], and performed throughout the country.

Agathe's siblings are: Rupert von Trapp (1911–92), Maria Franziska von Trapp (1914), Werner von Trapp (1915–2007), Hedwig von Trapp (1917–72), Johanna von Trapp (1919–94) and Martina von Trapp (1921–51). Her half-siblings are: Rosemarie von Trapp (1929), Eleonore von Trapp (1931) and Johannes von Trapp (1939).
