**Johanna Karolina Gobertina Barbara (Franziska) von Trapp** (7 September 1919 – 25 November 1994) was the sixth child of Georg Ritter von Trapp and his first wife, Agathe Whitehead. She was a member of the Trapp Family Singers, whose lives were the inspiration for the play and film *The Sound of Music*.<sup>[1]</sup> She was portrayed as the character "Marta".
